



Great Lakes Energy 2021 Scholarship Application

- Availability:** Great Lakes Energy is offering four scholarships for the 2021-22 academic year: Two scholarships for students pursuing a degree related to Electrical Engineering. Two scholarships for students pursuing a degree related to Information Technology.
- Award Amount:** \$2,500 each for full-time students or \$1,250 each for part-time students, for use at any accredited university or college in the United States. The scholarship must be used for educational purposes.
- Frequency:** One annual award; previous scholarship recipients are eligible to apply.
- Deadline:** **Completed applications must be submitted by March 31, 2021.** All supporting materials and documentation must be included with the application and submitted to hr@glenergy.com OR Great Lakes Energy, 1323 Boyne Avenue, Attention Human Resources, Boyne City, MI 49712.
- Eligibility:**
- Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, based on a 4.0 scale.
 - Applicant must be a resident of Michigan.
 - Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll at an accredited university or college for the 2021 fall term and/or 2022 spring term.
- Evaluation:** Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: academic and other achievements, community service and other volunteer work, personal statement of educational and career goals, essay, letters of recommendation, and GPA. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Notification:** All applicants will be notified on the status of their application by May 1, 2021.
