



Great Lakes Energy Cooperative 2023/24 Scholarship Application

- Availability:** Great Lakes Energy (GLE) is a not-for-profit electric cooperative with nearly 300 employees serving more than 125,000 members in rural areas of northern and western Michigan. We are pleased to offer six scholarships in the 2023-24 academic year for students pursuing certification or a degree related to a Pre-Apprentice Electrical Lineworker program.
- Award Amount:** \$1,000 each for full-time students for use at any accredited educational institution in Michigan. The scholarship must be used for educational purposes.
- Frequency:** One annual award; previous scholarship recipients are eligible to apply.
- Deadline:** **Completed applications must be submitted by March 31, 2023.** All supporting materials and documentation must be included with the application and submitted to hr@glenergy.com OR Great Lakes Energy Cooperative, 1323 Boyne Avenue, Attention Human Resources, Boyne City, MI 49712.
- Eligibility:**
- Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, based on a 4.0 scale.
 - Applicant must be a resident of Michigan.
 - Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll at an accredited educational institution during the 2023/24 academic year.
- Evaluation:** Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: academic and other achievements, community service and other volunteer work, personal statement of educational and career goals, essay, letters of recommendation, and GPA. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Notification:** All applicants will be notified on the status of their application by May 1, 2023.
