



Great Lakes Energy Cooperative 2025/26 Scholarship Application

Availability: Great Lakes Energy (GLE) is a not-for-profit electric cooperative with nearly 300 employees serving more than 125,000 members in rural areas of northern and western Michigan. We are pleased to offer four scholarships in the 2025-26 academic year: two scholarships for students pursuing a degree related to Electrical Engineering and two scholarships for students pursuing a degree related to Information Technology.

Award Amount: \$2,500 each for full-time students or \$1,250 each for part-time students, for use at any accredited university or college in the United States. The scholarship must be used for educational purposes.

Frequency: One annual award; previous scholarship recipients are eligible to apply.

Deadline: **Completed applications must be submitted by March 31, 2025.** All supporting materials and documentation must be included with the application and submitted to tmix@glenergy.com OR Great Lakes Energy Cooperative, 1323 Boyne Avenue, Attention Travis Mix, Boyne City, MI 49712.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, based on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must be a resident of Michigan.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll at an accredited university or college for the 2025 fall term and/or 2026 spring term.

Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: academic and other achievements, community service and other volunteer work, personal statement of educational and career goals, essay, letters of recommendation, and GPA. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Notification: All applicants will be notified on the status of their application by May 1, 2025.
